Objectives

- Promote awareness and understanding of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
- Encourage teamwork and collaboration among players.
- Enhance communication skills and creativity.
- Foster problem-solving and critical thinking abilities.
- Understanding of SDGs through Empathizing with a real person story

Step by Step Instructions

- Get a team of maximum 5-6 players, show them the backpack and explain that they have been hired to solve the mystery of the backpack. Give them the 1st Letter with the space to write.

Tips for facilitator/adaptations/notes...

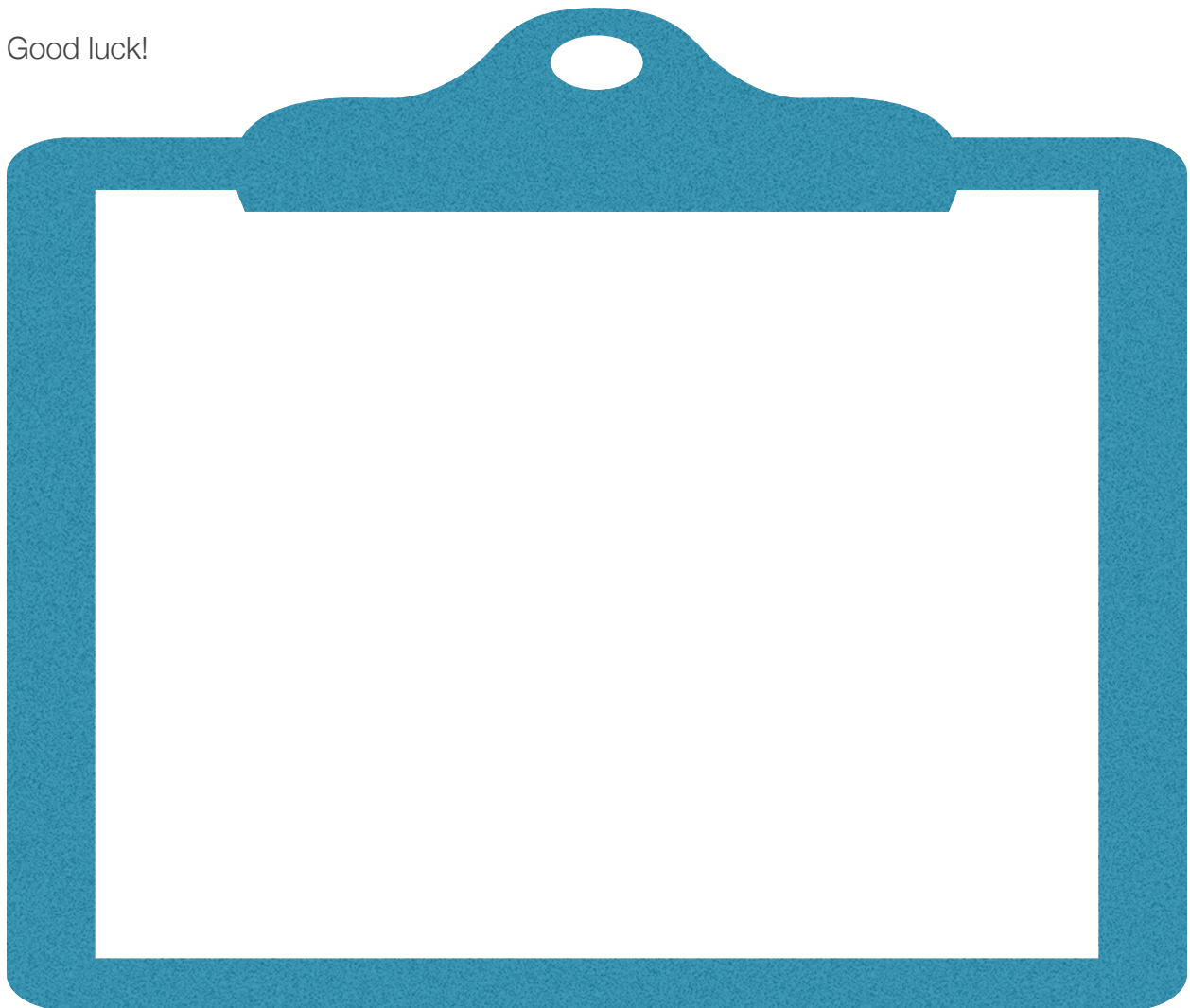
- Try to not intervene unless is needed, the role of educator is to let them discover by themselves and not interrupt the learning process and game flow.
